Items to Bring:

- Paint, paint thinners, solvents, cleaning products
- Weed and bug killers, insecticides, lawn fertilizers
- Contaminated motor oil, brake fluid
- Swimming pool or hobby chemicals
- Fluorescent lamps
- Cylinders (propane or helium)
- Batteries
- Fuel

Don't Bring:

- Agricultural, commercial or medical waste
- Explosives
- Asbestos and dioxin bearing wastes
- Radioactive material or Poison A gases
- Leaking containers
- Demolition debris
- No containers larger than 5 gallons



Douglas County Residents Only—Proof of Residency is Required

Personal ID and PUD, Water or Phone Bill

How do you know if a product is hazardous? If the label mentions the words **pesticide, caustic, acid, flammable, warning, danger or poison**, it is considered hazardous.

- Keep products in original containers.
- Store them so they don't tip over during transportation.
- Keep away from children, pets, passenger compartments of vehicle.
- Separate paint from other materials.
